HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Health Effects

Swallowed: Very low potential.
Eye: Avoid direct eye contact, low irritancy potential.
Skin: Very low irritancy potential.
Inhaled: Avoid direct inhalation. May cause irritation to mucus membranes.

First Aid

Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Drink plenty of water. Seek medical advice.
Eye: Irrigate eye with copious quantities of water for at least 10 minutes. Seek medical advice.
Skin: Wash off with water.
Inhaled: Unlikely to be a hazard. Move to fresh air.

Advice to Doctor: Treat symptomatically.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Exposure Limits: TLV 100 ppm
Ventilation: Provide sufficient (general and /or local) exhaust to maintain a level below TLV'S.
Personal Protection: Contains Ammonia, but at incorporation level to be very mild, however, to minimise any irritation to skin, rubber gloves should be worn. Avoid direct inhalation, which may cause mild irritation to mucus membranes.
Flammability: Non flammable

SAFETY HANDLING INFORMATION

Storage and Transport: Store in a cool dry area, not more than 30 Deg C. Keep out of direct sunlight.
Spills and Disposal: Mop up spills with absorbent material, dispose of in accordance with local rules and regulations.
Fire/Explosive Hazard: Non Flammable. Extinguishing media – use foam or dry chemical.
